

SPECIAL PROVISIONS EXCLUSIVELY FOR BASELWORLD 2022

Notwithstanding clause 18.2, paragraph 1 of the General Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (as at September 2020), if an exhibition is cancelled by MCH before its official opening day for reasons in accordance with clause 18.1 of the General Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (as at September 2020), the exhibitor is not obliged to contribute to the costs incurred by MCH up to the time of cancellation.

This means that the net fee for the Exhibition Space or for the participation package will be repaid to you in full if and insofar as a down payment has been made in this respect.

MCH and the exhibitor are each released from their contractual obligations to perform at the time of cancellation of the Exhibition; any claims the exhibitor may have against MCH, including but not limited to, claims for damages and reimbursement of expenses (e.g. booth construction services, hotel bookings, travel costs, etc.), which the exhibitor has already incurred in connection with his participation in the exhibition, shall be, and hereby are, released, waived and forever discharged.

The remaining provisions of clause 18.2 shall remain applicable without change.

In addition to clause 17 of the General Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (as of September 2020), the following applies to Baselworld 2022:

If an exhibitor or co-exhibitor has to cancel his participation in Baselworld 2022 after registration because either the country in which he is domiciled is on the official risk list of the Swiss Federal Office of Public Health or Switzerland is on the official risk list of his country of domicile, the exhibitor or co exhibitor shall not owe any lump-sum compensation and shall not make any claims for damages to MCH that are exclusively related to this withdrawal.

After having registered, any exhibitor or co-exhibitor may cancel his participation in Baselworld 2022 for any reason whatsoever up to 31 January 2022 without having to pay a lump-sum compensation and shall not make any claims for compensation from MCH exclusively in connection with this withdrawal.

Cancellations after 1 February 2022 will be dealt with in accordance with the existing provisions in clause 17 of the General Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions (as at September 2020). All other provisions of Clause 17 which are not adapted by the above regulations shall continue to apply without restriction.

The Exhibitor acknowledges that the provisions contained in this section apply exclusively to Baselworld 2022 and neither implicitly nor explicitly to editions in the following years
